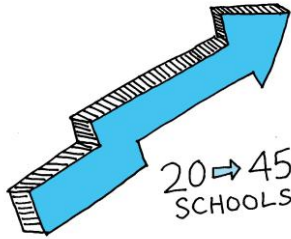

1 Over the past 5 years, the number of Right Brain schools has grown from 20 to 45 – more than doubling in size. (page1)

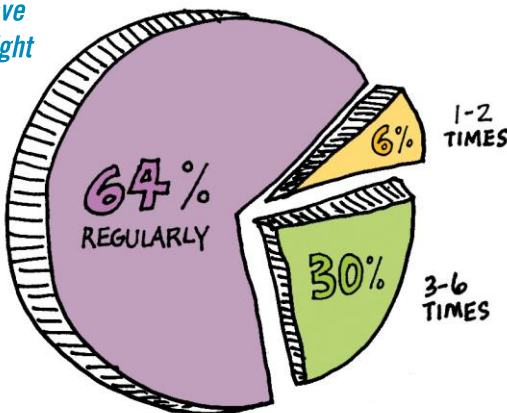

2 In Right Brain residencies, students engage in the use of 21st century skills nearly twice as often, compared to ongoing classroom instruction. (page2)

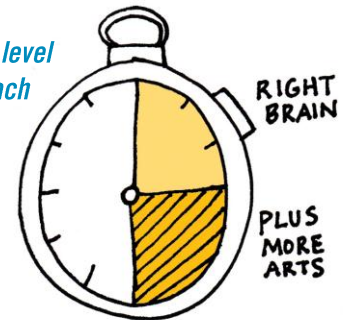
3 Teachers who have participated in Right Brain trainings are using arts-based strategies. (page3)
